The release of the aluminium Sailfish Shelf Runner catamaran delivers a whole new dimension of adventure and performance for offshore fishermen

The Sailfish brand is universally recognised as a clear cut market leader in aluminium catamarans. With the release of the new Shelf Runner model, the Sailfish designers have turned their attention to the more affordable end of the trailerable catamaran market.

The new design Shelf Runner delivers a huge fishing cockpit. The hull boasts supreme quality, performance and stability. For those who appreciate the benefits of a year round hardtop configuration, the Shelf Runner is also manufactured with a stylish aluminium hardtop.

"This boat establishes the benchmark for alloy hulls", said Gavan Daly of Webbe Marine. "The big Shelf Runner with its huge cockpit and wide beam allows you to get a lot of boat, it is superb value for money. Stability is crucial for fishing offshore. The hardtop version has to be one of the very few boats available in this size category that offers such a wonderful feature. For protection from the weather or a searing sun, the hardtop is highly rated in many parts of Australia.

The Shelf Runner hull has been designed to withstand offshore conditions boasting a length overall of 6.34 metres and a beefy beam of 2.45 metres. Such is the volume of the boat you could almost fit two monohulls inside the Shelf Runner catamaran. This all results in a massive fishing space for plenty of anglers on board.

For those looking to take the Shelf Runner to the next level there is an optional Enclosed Hardtop with Windscreen Wiper. "The Enclosed Hardtop has proven to be a very popular option and gives the driver a commanding feel at the helm usually found in a lot larger boats," says Gavan.

Other notable features include Garmin 750S touch screen GPS/plotter/depth sounder, Fusion stereo and VHF radio. The Shelf Runner also includes bolster seats for the skipper and passenger, ample space for storage in bins, live bait tank with pump and drain, 10 rod holders, deck wash and custom aluminium trailer. The impressive list goes on.

Two Honda four stroke outboards guarantee that the on-water performance is not compromised. Webbe Marine recommends dual Honda 75hp engines for the Sailfish Shelf

61 km/h. Boaters looking to get offshore a little faster can always upgrade to dual Honda 90hp outboards.
